Saturday, August 13

Arrive at the Shannon Airport in Ireland this morning where you will be met by our staff and transferred to the Killarney Park Hotel in County Kerry. This hotel is one of Ireland's premier 5 star hotels and is superbly located adjacent to the center of town. It offers the perfect base from which to pursue a host of outdoor activities including golf on Kerry's premier courses, river and lake fishing, horse riding and trekking through Killarney's spectacular National Park. Enjoy a drink in the bar and our welcome dinner at the hotel this evening.

Sunday, August 14

Play an optional round of golf at Killarney Killeen Course (Irish Open Course 2010 and Solheim Cup 2011) or take the sightseeing tour with the non-golfers to the scenic Gap of Dunloe. You will enjoy a leisurely pace on a horse drawn jaunting cart and a boat ride on the Lakes of Killarney to Ross Castle, with a short visit of Kate Kearney's cottage. Or you may choose to visit Muckross House & Gardens on the outskirts of town for a worthwhile visit of a traditional Irish farm homestead.

Monday, August 15

Golfers will enjoy a round of golf today at Tralee. Designed by Arnold Palmer, this stunning setting represents a true paradise for those willing to challenge what is widely acclaimed as one of the finest links courses in the world. Smitten at first sight, Palmer would later go on record with his memorable quote "I may have designed the first nine, but surely God designed the back nine". For non-golfers, travel along the world famous Ring of Kerry visiting the towns of Waterville, Sneem and Kenmare before returning to Killarney in the afternoon.

This evening you are on your own to enjoy one of Killarney's fine restaurants or sample a variety of pub fare, all within walking distance.

Tuesday, August 16

Golf today is at Old Head Golf Links which is built on a 220-acre diamond of land, jutting out over two miles into the Atlantic. The promontory is almost an island with numerous caves running beneath your feet as you play the course. Unrivalled in terms of the magnificent beauty and setting of the site located in the southwest of Ireland, Old Head Golf Links continues to take the golfing world by storm and remains one of the most sought after golf experiences anywhere on earth.



Today the non golfers can choose to take an excursion to Blarney Castle and also visit the Cobh Heritage Center. Cobh, formerly known as Queenstown, was from where the Titanic set sail on it's last voyage. The center has memorabilia from the Irish emigrant ships which carried so many Irish men and women across the Atlantic Ocean after the Potato Famine in the 1840's.



Wednesday, August 17

Today will be a group sightseeing and touring day. Take a rest from the golf and meetings and enjoy an excursion on the Dingle Peninsula visiting the town of Dingle, the Gallarus Oratory and marvel at the breathtaking views from Sleat Head.



Thursday, August 18

This morning, you will check out of Killarney Park Hotel. Golfers will play Ballybunion, one of the finest links courses in the world. Wild and intimidating, but stunningly beautiful on the Atlantic coastline of North Kerry. Later this afternoon, check into Adare Manor Hotel & Golf Resort in County Limerick. Non golfers may choose to spend a leisurely morning in Killarney before heading to Adare Manor in the afternoon to meet up with the golfers after their round at Ballybunion.



Friday, August 19

Optional round of golf at Adare Manor (Irish Open Course 2007 & 2008). Non-golfers may visit the Cliffs of Moher and Bunratty Castle before returning to Adare Village in the afternoon. Golfers may also want to consider playing Lahinch while the non-golfers are touring the Cliffs of Moher.

Check out of Adare Manor and transfer to the Shannon Airport for your return flight home to the United States.
